

**HOMEWOOD-FLOSSMOOR PARK DISTRICT
DECLINATION OF GROUP HEALTH CARE INSURANCE COVERAGE**

In exchange for a stipend of \$_____ paid on the first two payrolls of each month, I hereby agree to decline and waive individual and/or family group health insurance benefits from the Homewood-Flossmoor Park District that may otherwise be available to me. The above stated monthly stipend will be effective upon the first full calendar month in which I (and my spouse/dependents) am not otherwise covered by the Homewood-Flossmoor Park District group health insurance plan. I understand that by waiving such benefits, I (and my spouse/dependents) will be subject to re-enrollment rules and regulations of the Homewood-Flossmoor Park District group health insurance plan, including but not limited to re-enrollment dates and exclusions. Additionally, in the event I waive group health insurance benefits and I (and my spouse/dependents) am not otherwise covered by a medical insurance policy, I (and my spouse/dependents) may be subject to penalties assessed under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ie. Affordable Care Act). I understand this stipend is taxable income to me, included on the year-end W-2 statement.
