DISCUSSION

a. 2026 – 2027 Goals

President Bachus opened the annual goals meeting by recognizing the Homewood-Flossmoor Park District's accomplishments at the recent IPRA/IAPD Soaring to New Heights Conference: room host volunteers; session presenters; Oralethea Davenport elected to the IPRA Foundation Board of Trustees; Mike Gianatasio sworn in to the IPRA Board of Directors; Devin Frendreis, Diversity Section Distinguished Member Award; Marketing Department, First Place, Short Form Video; and Distinguished Agency Accreditation.

Executive Director Boehm reviewed that all park district departments brainstormed on suggested goals for the upcoming year. Ideas were discussed and refined and goals determined for each of the park district's six core values. Some suggested goals have monetary considerations, which will be addressed further as the budget process continues over the next month.

President Bachus acknowledged the work that has already gone into this process. He then started the discussion by asking those present to consider if the current six core values still align with the park district's strategy and are still appropriate core values.

Commissioner Bachus then led the group through each of the core values by inviting the department that suggested the goal to explain it further, entertain discussion, and answer questions.

President Bachus thanked everyone for the time and energy put into the goals process and into fitting what was discussed into budgeting for the next fiscal year.
